

Bingo Question Instructions.

The initial version of bingo has two built in question banks each of the same level of difficulty. There are two to provide some level of variety.

Ideally there would be many more banks, of varying difficulties, but unfortunately it is a long task to produce enough new question lists. If you like Bingo and would like more variety or a different set of questions please use the following instructions to create a new question list to be incorporated into Bingo.

Please download the questions as file by right clicking and selecting "save as".

Open the text file in a text editor (Such as Notepad for Windows users) not a word processor.

You will see one of the question banks I have written. The first few lines look like this:

```
questionM_array[0] = "8 \div 8"
questionM_array[1] = "44 \div 22"
questionM_array[2] = "27 \div 9"
questionM_array[3] = "16 \div 4"
questionM_array[4] = "2.5 \times 2"
```

Change the questions within the quotation marks to new ones. Please keep the questions to less than 10 characters. If this limitation prevents you from compiling a satisfactory list you can go over to 15 but please make it clear in your email you have done this. Also be aware I will make it fit by shrinking the text which will make it harder to see on the whiteboard

<u>Tricky bit:</u> Computers start counting at zero. So the first question will have the answer of 1 but it will show as questionM_array[0]. The second question will have the answer of 2 but be questionM_array[1]. Once you get a few questions along this becomes surprisingly confusing. Always add 1 to the index for what the answer should be.

All 90 questions must be present, which does make themed lists quite a challenge.

When completed save the file as a .as file.

Please put the subject heading of bingo and let me know by what name you would like to be acknowledged by on your custom version of Bingo.
